Many Ohio wineries have added ciders and craft brews to their list of quality beverages offered to their clients.

Vintage Ohio, about five years ago recognized the interest among “serious” connoisseurs of craft beverages of every type and added beers brewed by our members to an area adjacent to Festival Field.

This year, we are delighted to be adding three winery-brewed offerings for guests who love beer too to enjoy.

For an additional purchase price [under the permit which allows the festival to exist, Ohio law does not allow beer and wine in the same designated area], brews from the following wineries will be available.*

Double Wing Brewing Company is housed adjacent to the Debonné Vineyards, the state’s largest estate winery in Madison

Maize Valley Craft Brewery is housed at Maize Valley Winery in Hartville along with their Farmers’ Market and Family FunZone

The Pine Lake Brewing Company is located in Columbiana, the home of the beautiful Pine Lake Winery, Restaurant, and Event Center
