



Food of nearly every variety to be offered at Vintage Ohio 2023

The menu selections are more wide ranging than ever at this year's festival. Menus submitted to date include:

Scott's Fire and Ice: a wide selection of wood-fired on-site pizza offerings.

Hidden Café will be selling Gyros, Philly Steak sandwiches, Fries and Lemon shakes.

Ohio Farm Direct will offer grass fed cheeseburgers, grilled cheese, Reuben burgers, hot dogs, lettuce wraps as well as grass fed ice cream cones.

Queen Bee will offer coffees, teas, espresso, iced coffee, hot chocolate, flavored coffees, smoothies, fresh fruit cups, and milkshakes.

Sue's Pierogi's will serve yummy ethnic platters, several fried items, and hot pretzels.

Dynamic Dogs have planned several 'dawgs,' including Coney dawgs, Polish boys, a Dawg pound, Dynamic Dawgs along with a garlic parmesan potato.

Jelly Jeans Comfort Cuisine will serve pork and chicken schnitzel sandwiches, chicken tender baskets, quesadillas, pierogis chicken and falafel wraps, fruit or cheese cups and cheese curds.

Buckeye Concessions will return with Kettle corn, cinnamon almonds, cashews, and pecans.

Angellos 2 U will offer Italian subs, roasted red pepper chicken sandwiches, mini cannoli, garlic parmesan fries, meatball sandwiches and fresh chicken sticks.

The Cleveland Fish and Seafood Company will be submitting their menus shortly.

Rocheck Concessions will be selling smoked chicken wings, smoked sausage burgers, bratwurst, and fresh cut fries.

Hunger Squad will offer their shrimp and cheesy grits, cilantro lime rice bowls, spinach artichoke chicken flat bread, pulled pork on a pretzel bun and assorted fries.

Gary's World-famous Foods is serving their Italian sausage, boneless ribs and sirloin steak tips, angus burgers, hot dogs, corn dogs, chicken tender baskets, fries, and mozzarella sticks.
